Teaching and research activities

Activities during the year were in line with the Foundation's objectives. In spring and autumn, the 57th and 58th block courses were successfully held, again as in person courses.

Colleagues from Switzerland and abroad took part as additional lecturers. Both courses were held in English.

The second part of the series of lectures on clinical psychiatry organized for undergraduate and postgraduate students by Rolf Inderbitzi in 2023 was held via Zoom by the Psychiatric University Clinic Zurich.

During the year, two students successfully completed their diploma:

- Joanna Dovalis from America with her thesis: *The Pearl. Accidents and the Unconscious: An Initiation into the Mysteries.*
- Sabine Mayer-Patzel from Germany with her thesis: *Drachenkind und Drachenreiten – die Wandlung der Beziehung zum Drachen. (Dragon Child and Dragon Riding– Change in the Relationship to the Dragon).*

One student passed the intermediate propaedeutic exams and received the license to work with patients under supervision.

The results of basic research were presented and discussed by the participating lecturers and students in their papers and presentations.

Board and Steering Committee

Theodor Abt retired from the Board and the Steering Committee in November 2024.

Eva Wertenschlag and Judith Harris were Co-Presidents in 2024. In December 2024 Eva Wertenschlag retired as Co-President and Judith Harris took over the Presidency.

Financial matters

The Steering Committee has changed the accounting system to increase the transparency in the profit and loss account. Details can be found in the annual financial statements.

It is worth noting that the block courses continue to be funded from the Foundation's assets. The Foundation's work and contributions to support research are also paid from the Foundation's assets.

In addition, nine scholarships totalling CHF 14,012.50 were awarded. As part of the Foundation's objectives, awards totalling CHF 25,000.– were made for book projects and publication contributions.
